This day came the parties by their attorneys who waving the trial of the issue in this case by a jury agree to submit the same to the judgment of the Court and being fully heard it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendants thirty dollars, parcel of the debt in the declaration mentioned with legal interest thereon from the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1864 till paid, and his costs by him in this behalf expended

Prince Attorney for the Commonwealth in this Court amounting to forty dollars - One in favor of Wm W Briggs Sheriff of this County amounting to Forty five dollars One in favor of Owen White clerk of this Court amounting to fifty two <sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars & One in favor of John Brown amounting to five dollars and forty cents be legally certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination and payment.
