

as to be heard on the Plaintiff's bill and Exhibit thereto filed, Defendant's answer and general replication thereto, and was argued by Counsel, in consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge Order as desired, and that Wm B. Shandy be appointed Trustee in & Certain care of Trust of the 5th of November 1858, Executed by Wm B. Shandy to Henry S. Howard as Trustee, to secure Certain debts due to Stephen M. Briggs and Richard J. Gardner, in the place of the said Henry S. Howard, now dead, and that the said Wm B. Shandy is as fully vested with all the rights, duties and powers of the said Trustee as if he had been originally appointed by the grantor in the said Deed.

The last Will and Testament of E. A. Oliver dead, was proved by the Oaths of R. C. Wells one of the subscribing witnesses thereto; and A. J. Vick and Allen Barrett the other subscribing witnesses being dead, R. C. Wells testified what the said A. J. Vick and Allen Barrett and himself Subscribed their names as witnesses to the said will, in the presence and at the request of the Testatrix and in the presence of each other. Thereupon it is ordered that the said will be recorded as and for the last Will and Testament of E. A. Oliver dead and Richard Barrett the Executor named in the said Will being dead, in the Office of Jas. P. Bryant, who made Oath according to law, and together with Jas. E. Lawrence and C. C. Vaughan, his Securities, who justified in Oath as to their Sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged to him in the penalty of five hundred dollars, conditions according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Jas. P. Bryant for obtaining Letters of administration on the Estate of the said E. A. Oliver dead with his will aforesaid annexed in due form.

Ordered that C. C. Vaughan, Jas. P. Bryant and A. W. Knapp being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise and the goods and Chattels of E. A. Oliver dead and return the Appraisement under their hands at the law directed.

In the Application of Jas. B. Vick, he retained ardently spirit at his Store in this County. The Court certifies that the place where the same is to be sold is fit and convenient and that the Applicant is a person of Sobriety and good character.

Ordered that the account of Mrs. Josephine Howard, faith of this County, amounting to Seventy Eight dollars, be Certified
