W. J. Richardson, John J. Coker, J. S. Yates, J. J. Turner, D. J. Watkins, W. H. Bradshaw, Thomas Bradshaw, J. L. Council, J. S. Vincent, R. G. Edwards, J. T. Hill & C. C. Williams who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oaths do say: We the jury find for the plaintiff and award damages for six visits, at five dollars and two at ten dollars per visit making \$40⁰⁰. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the Defendant forty dollars the damages aforesaid as aforesaid with legal interest thereon from this 21st day of November 1871 till paid and her costs in this behalf expended.

Ordered that J. E. Sebrill & Thos. Simmons be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose do let to the lowest undertaker the contract for removing raft that may from against Carys Bridge from January 1st 1872 to January 1st 1873 including the present raft. And report to Court.
