

Ordered that L. B. Cobb, John Campbell & M. M. Clayton being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of George M. Garner dec'd. and return the appraisal under their hands according to law.

The Court doth assign Samuel B. Prillow Guardian to his infant daughter Mary A. J. Prillow and thereupon the said Samuel B. Prillow with J. D. Prillow his security, who justified on oath as to his sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned according to law - which bond is ordered to be recorded.

George Crocker who stands indicted for Rape was set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and being arraigned pleaded not guilty to the Indictment. And a panel of twenty four jurors summoned by the Sheriff, were examined by the Court found free from all legal exceptions and qualified to serve as jurors according to law. Thereupon the named was erased from the panel eight of said jurors, and from the remaining sixteen the following twelve jurors were selected by lot, to whom there was no objection, to wit Arnold Kitchen, Richard B. Joyner, Nathan Pope, Wm. J. Gray, Amos J. Pope, Exum Garrio, J. A. Bishop, Miles Worrell, D. T. Webb, H. V. Cobb, Tho. E. Joyner & William Beale who were sworn the truth of and upon the premises to speak and having heard the evidence upon their oaths do say "That the jury find the prisoner guilty and ascertains the term of his imprisonment in the Penitentiary to be ten years" And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to jail.

Ordered that the account of George W. Spivey Constable amounting to \$29⁴⁵ & the debt W. W. Briggs account of Carr B. Scott amounting to \$7.20 be severally certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination & payment.

Sent to J. M. Corbitt. Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County Treasurer pay out of the County levy to Lucius Corbitt five dollars for copying registration books for the use of this Court.

" Upon the application of Dr. J. J. Prillow jr. ^{for leave to alter the road running near his house} C. C. Williams, C. B. Prince & William Whitehead are appointed Commissioners viewers to view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public of a change in the said road in front of his residence as proposed, and especially whether any yard or garden, orchard or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.

The report of the Commissioners appointed to assign dower to Sarah J. Miskell in the real estate whereof her deceased husband Geo. Miskell died seized having lam one month upwards and no exceptions being filed thereto it was examined & confirmed by the Court & ordered to be recorded.

An Inquest taken upon the view of the body of Ben Old, col^d, on the 5 September 1841 was returned and ordered to be filed.
