George Crocker who stands convicted of Rape was again set to the Bar in custody of the jailer of this Court and it being demanded of him if any thing for himself he had or knew to say why the Court should not now pronounce judgment against him according to law and nothing being offered or alleged in defence of judgment it is therefore considered by the Court that the said George Crocker be imprisoned in the Commonwealth Penitentiary of this Commonwealth for the term of ten years the period by the jurors in their verdict ascertained. And the Sheriff of this County is ordered as soon as possible after the adjournment of this Court to remove and safely convey the said George Crocker from the jail of this County to the Penitentiary of this Commonwealth there to be kept imprisoned and treated in the manner directed by law for the term aforesaid. And the prisoner is remanded to jail.
