

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let the building of a Boat & purchasing a rope for Monroe Ferry this day made the following report to wit, "We the undersigned Commissioners ordered by Court to let the rebuilding of a Boat and purchasing a Rope for Monroe Ferry would report that we met and let the rebuilding of said boat and purchasing of said rope and Mr Benj I Bryant became the contractor at One hundred and nineteen and seventy five cents (\$119.75) We beg to further Report that we met on March 6th and received said boat and rope Jos G Crumpler, James Vaughan & John Cobb - Commissioners March 7, 1872." Whereupon the Court ratifies and confirms the said report.

Ordered that J M Corbett County Treasurer out of the County levy pay Benj I Bryant for the benefit of Wm C Myrick, One hundred & nineteen ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ Dollars for building a Ferry Boat and purchasing a Rope for the Monroe Ferry.

By consent of parties it is ordered that the license heretofore granted to Bryant & Brantley to retail ardent ardent spirits at their store in this County be and they are hereby transferred to Bryant & Daugherty according to law It appearing to the Court the said Bryant & Daugherty are persons of Sobriety and good character

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On the petition of Joseph M Prince one of the Justices of George M Hughes on his official bond as Constable in the Township of Drewrysville in this County and desires to be relieved from said Suretyship It is ordered that the said George M Hughes be summoned to appear here and show cause if any he has why he should not be required to execute a new bond with security according to law Whereupon the said George M Hughes appeared in Court and acknowledged due notice of this motion and being fully heard It is ordered that the said Hughes execute a new bond with security according to law and the penalty thereof is to be in the sum of two thousand dollars and conditioned according to law and the said George M Hughes refusing to execute the said bond it is ordered that he be and is hereby removed from the said Office of Constable, and that he pay the said Prince his costs in this behalf expended.

On the petition of Benjamin E Morrell Security of R M Hendree Barnes on his official bond as Constable against the said Barnes for a new bond with security. This day came the said Morrell by his attorney and the summons awarded against the said Barnes being returned executed and he being solemnly called and not appearing It is considered by the Court that the said R M Hendree Barnes execute a new bond with good security in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to law and that the said bond and security be given on or before the first day of the next term of this Court.
