to the Court that notice in writing of this application has been given to Orvis Moore the appraiser who appraised the said land to which notice was appended an affidavit of the applicant that in his opinion the appraisement of his lands is above the true value thereof. The Court after hearing the applicant and the attorney for the Commonwealth in this Court who was present defending the interest of the Commonwealth and all the evidence adduced is satisfied that the appraisement of the said tract of land is too high, that nine dollars per acre is the true value of the said tract of land. It is therefore ordered that the appraisement be corrected by charging the said tract of land at nine dollars per acre.
