

Office on the second day after any election held in this County and determine the persons who have received the greatest number of Votes in the County for the several offices voted for in such election -

On the motion of James E. Lebrell who made oath according to law & together with Wm. A. Lebrell & John N. Lebrell his securities, who justified me as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of David Nicholson deceased in due form.

Ordered that W. B. Saunders, J. G. Little, R. F. Barnard & A. W. James or any three of them, being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of David Nicholson deceased and return the appraisement under their hand according to Law -

Ordered the application of Mills Abbott, Mr. W. Beaton, J. M. Corbett & Edwin Harris who wish establish the road leading from Branches Bridge road to Hopkins Bridge road by the residence of the petitioners as a County road. It is ordered that Jas. M. Corbett, Mills Abbott & John W. Harris who are appointed for the Purpose do view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences & inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public if such road shall be as proposed, and especially whether any yard, garden or orchard or any part thereof will be in such case have to be taken. Whereupon the Commissioners made their report. And on consideration thereof it is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said road be established as a public highway.

It is ordered by this Court that Kenneth R. Griffin be, and he is hereby appointed an agent for this County, for the following purpose & none other, viz., to proceed to the Town of Danville Va. and receive from the President of the Norfolk & G.W.R.R.C. or such Officer of that Company as may be designated by the President, the bonds issued by the County of Southampton in favor of said Norfolk & G.W.R.R.C. that he the said Kenneth R. Griffin bring the said bonds to the County seat of Southampton County and deliver them to the Clerk of the County Court of said County for the purpose of having the conditions upon which said bonds were issued properly endorsed thereon or inserted therein.

Ordered that James M. Corbett County Treasurer advance out of the County Levy in his hands, to Kenneth R. Griffin fifty dollars to defray expenses of his visit to Danville Va. on business as agent of this County -
