" Laura Crawley who stands indicted of Stealing bank notes & P was set to the Bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and being thereof arraigned Pleadet not guilty to the Indictment and a panel of sixteen persons summoned by the Sheriff were examined by the Court found free from all legal exception and qualified to serve as jurors according to law Thereupon the accused peremptorily challenged four of the jurors and the remaining twelve jurors to wit Selathiel Lewis Zachariah Johnson Thomas E. Johnson, R. E. Davis, Meritt Johnson, J. H. Rollings, Geo. W. Stephenson, James T. Puckett, Lewis Gillette, Aug. Crumpler, J. G. Crumpler, James H. Williams were sworn the truth of and upon the premises to speak and having heard the evidence upon their oaths do say: We the jury find the prisoner guilty of petty larceny and we order her confinement in the County jail sixty days. And thereupon it being demanded of the said Laura Crawley if any thing for herself she has or knows to say why the Court should not proceed to pronounce judgment against her according to law and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment. It is considered by the Court that the said Laura Crawley be confined in the jail of this County for <sup>term</sup> of sixty days the period by the jurors in their verdict ascertained and thereafter until she pay the costs of this prosecution or be otherwise discharged by due course of law.

Amos Joyner who stands indicted for Petit Larceny was set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court Whereupon on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for reasons appearing to the Court the trial of the said Amos Joyner is adjourned till the first day of the next Term of this Court

Moore Huffs who stands indicted of murder was set to the Bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and being thereof arraigned upon his arraignment demands to be tried in the Circuit Court having jurisdiction over this County

Joshua Crumpler & Fannie Crumpler here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted to the Commonwealth in the sum of One hundred dollars of their respective goods and chattels and of immovables to be levied and to the use of the Commonwealth rendered  
Yet upon this condition that if the said Joshua Crumpler & Fannie Crumpler do & shall personally appear before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next Term of the said Court and give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth against Moore Huffs who stands indicted of murder, and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue -

It appearing to the Court <sup>that</sup> the jail of this Court is inefficient and unsafe it is ordered that Moore Huffs who is confined therein charged with murder be removed to the jail of the City of Norfolk for safe keeping -

" Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning ten o'clock
