On the motion of W. W. Briggs It is ordered that the order heretofore made committing the estate of Thomas N Briggs dec^d to Samuel Kello late Sheriff of this County for administration be and the same is hereby set aside -

For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that William W Briggs Sheriff of this County take into his hands the estate of Thomas N Briggs dec^d undistributed by Samuel Kello former administrator, and administer the same according to law

On the motion of Depe S. Basham & Benj. Robinson they are exempted from payment of taxes & fees in future they being aged and infirm

Ordered that the following accounts be paid One in favor of W. W. Briggs amounting to \$27.⁰⁰ One in favor of W. B. Prince attorney for the attorney for the Commonwealth amounting to \$15.⁰⁰ One in favor of James E. Harris amounting to \$17.¹⁷ and the account of G. C. Williams amounting to \$5.⁰⁰ be severally certified to the audit of Public accounts for his examination & payment

Ordered that W. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County return out of the contingent moneys in his hands three hundred sixty four dollars fourteen cents the amount of his account against the County of Southampton

Ordered that J. M. Corbett County Treasurer, out of the County levy pay H. R. Griffin one hundred and fifty dollars for professional services rendered -

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
