Story his Security, who justified on oath as to his Sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Jenkins also took and subscribed the oaths required by law.

Pickett who was elected Supervisor of the Township of Jerusalem in this County by the qualified voters thereof at the election held on the 23^d day of May 1872 for the term of one year commencing on the 1st day of July 1872 and after said Term of Office shall have expired until his Successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said Office this day with Thomas J. Pickett his Security (who justified on oath as to his Sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said J. D. Pickett also took and subscribed the oaths required by law.

Wm Prince who was elected Justice of the Peace in the Township Druryville Mills at Birth who was elected Justice of the Peace in the Township of Boykins. J. W. Duke who was elected Justice of the Peace in the Township of Berlin & Iron. & Walter B. Holman who was elected Justice of the Peace in the Township of Franklin at the election held on the 23^d May 1872 for the Term of three years commencing on the first day of July next were qualified by taking & subscribing the oaths required by law.
