And thereupon the said Thomas with J. B. Prince his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Thomas also took & subscribed the oath required by law.

James H. Johnson is appointed Commissioner of Roads in the Township of Druryville in this County to fill the vacancy caused by the failure of the said Johnson to qualify in due time for the term of one year commencing on the 1st day of July 1872, and after the said term of office shall have expired until his successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said office. And thereupon the said Johnson with P. J. Thomas his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law, which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Johnson also took and subscribed the oath required by law.
