

Ordered that the account of J. L. Story Constable amounting to Eight 98/100 dollars be Certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment

Ordered that John C. Griffin James G. Jones & A. T. Stephenson on the part of the County with Commissioners acting on the part of Isle of Wight County, let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Porcells Bridge, and embankment, across Black Water River. that they execute the same when completed according to Contract & make report to Court

The Commissioner of Roads in the Township of Jerusalem this day made the following report to this Court

"To the Hon. Judge of the County Court of Southampton County. I beg leave to report that I was directed by an order of the Jerusalem board August 26 1871 to let to the lowest undertaker the building of a bridge across a gut on the road leading from Jerusalem to the lower Appamoochick bridge that the work was let as directed the contract undertaken by Benj. E. Morrell, has been done according to Contract for the sum of thirty five (\$35.00) and I recommend that an order be made by the Hon. Court on the County Treasurer to pay said Benj. E. Morrell said sum

I beg leave also to report that on the same day I was directed by said board to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Black Creek bridge that it was let as directed, the contract undertaken by John T. Wills for the sum of Forty dollars (\$40.00) that the work has been done according to contract also necessary additional work which I think was worth five dollars (\$5.00) and I recommend that an order be made by the Hon. Court on the County Treasurer to pay said John T. Wills the sum of forty five dollars (\$45.00) All of which is respectfully submitted - Robt. Whitehead Com Roads Jerusalem Township." Which report the Court receives & ratifies.

Ordered that J. M. Corbett ^{County Treasurer} pay Benj. E. Morrell, out of the County levy the sum of thirty five dollars for building bridge across a gut for the road leading from Jerusalem to the lower Appamoochick Bridge.

Ordered that J. M. Corbett County Treasurer pay John T. Wills forty five dollars out of the County levy for repairs to Black Creek bridge.

Mills A. Britt a Justice of the Peace in the Township of Boykins Dept in this County this day paid into Court to the Clerk thereof the sum of five dollars, fine imposed by him against Henry Hafford, col^d. for a misdemeanor.

On the motion of Geo. E. Beaton to have a new road established commencing at D. H. Thomas and running by B. C. Wallers, Wm. Harris & Charles Lawsons to County road on the Southside of Augustus Smiths. It is ordered that D. H. Thomas, James H. Barnes and Lawson Beale who are appointed Commissioners for the purpose do view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result from to individuals as to the public if such road shall be opened as proposed, and especially whether any yard, garden, orchard, or any part thereof will in such case have to be taken.
