

Benj E Worrell is appointed Supervisor in the Township of Newsoms Depot in this County to supply the vacancy caused by J. Deyers not qualifying for the term of one year commencing on the 1st day of July 1872 and after the said term of Office shall have expired until his Successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties of said Office and thereupon the said Benj E Worrell with Wm. E Beale his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded.
