

Ordered that James G Jones Commissioner of Roads in the Berlin & Iron Townships do act on the part of this County with the Commissioner appointed on the part of Cole of Wight County in making sale of the old Timber left from the repairs of Broad ^{Wagon} Bridge and make report to this Court.

The Commissioners appointed by this Court to confer with Commissioners appointed on the part of Cole of Wight County in regard to the letting the rebuilding of Joyners Bridge across the ~~Black Water~~ ^{Black Water} River this day made the following report, to wit:
"On obedience to an order made by the County Court of Southampton, James Holmes B. Bowers and Henry V. Cobb was appointed Special Commissioners to confer with the Commissioners of Cole of Wight County for the purpose of letting out the bridge called Joyners Bridge across Black Water river and after giving sufficient notice of the time and place we the aforesaid Commissioners let the building of said bridge out, and Arnold Kitchen became the undertaker for three hundred and eighty three (\$383) dollars. The Bridge has been completed, and the aforesaid Commissioners of Southampton and Cole of Wight County met the 15th day of October and received the Bridge and report the same to Court - & Respectfully Submit it: James Holmes, Bartholomew Bowers, H. V. Cobb, Commissioners."
On consideration whereof the Court doth approve & ratify the said report.

Ordered that James M Corbett County treasurer pay to Isaac A Kitchen two hundred & twenty nine ^{and} 9/100 Dollars out of the County levy, it being this County's proportion for rebuilding Joyners bridge across Black Water River.

Davis Barrett & James M Williams are appointed Judges of election at Newson Depot in Newson Township, in the place of A. P. Pope & James D Darden who decline to act.

On the motion of Joseph M Bagham creditor in a certain Dced of Trust executed on the 10th day of May 1866. by John I Kindred & S. Antoinette his wife & Ben B Kindred grantors to Edward W Mansenburg, Trustee, and recorded in the Clerk's Office of this Court on the 12th day of May 1866. the said John I Kindred & Ben B Kindred being present & wearing the notice required by law consents to what follows to wit: that John R Kilby be appointed trustee in the dced of Trust aforesaid in the place of the said Edward W Mansenburg who is dead, and that the said John R Kilby be substituted to all the rights, powers, duties & responsibilities of the said Edward W Mansenburg.

On the motion of Wm W. Cobb one of the executors named in the last will and testament of Benj E Cobb dec. a copy of which has been heretofore admitted to probate in this Court - who made oath according to law and together with Edmund G Scott & Wm A Nicholson his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six thousand dollars conditioned according to law ^{which bond is ordered by a reporter} Certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate of the said Will in due form & liability being reserved to the other Executor to be joined in the said Probate when he thinks fit.
