

satisfaction of the Court the said Fulgence de Bordenave declared on oath in open Court that he will support the Constitution of the United States and that he doth absolutely and entirely renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince Potentate, State or Sovereignty, whatever, and particularly to the present Emperor of France. And thereupon the said Fulgence de Bordenave is admitted a citizen of the United States -

On the motion of Wm H. Jenkins who proposes establishing a road commencing from the corner of James H. Jenkins fence on the road leading from Jerusalem to Black Bridge to the road at or near the Union meeting house. The Commissioners appointed to let the line of the said road this day made their report which is in these words To wit -

" To the Hon Judge of Southampton Co Court We the undersigned Commissioners appointed to let and receive a road leading from the Jerusalem and Igner bridge road to Joannes Church have proceeded to directions to let out said bridge and hereby recommend Wm H. Jenkins J. A. Kitchen John Pickler & Co. done Oct 21st 1872. On consideration whereof the Court doth ratify and confirm the said report and hereby establish the said road as a public highway.

delin^y X Ordered that James M. Corbitt County Treasurer out of the County levy pay C. C. Williams three hundred & eighteen ⁷⁵/₁₀₀ dollars for opening a new road from the Jerusalem & Igner bridge road to Joannes Church.

delin^y X Ordered that James M. Corbitt County Treasurer out of the County levy pay C. C. Williams One hundred fifty two ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for repairs to bridge over the Stoway River at Jerusalem.
