were shown the truth of and upon the facts as he speaks and having heard the evidence
show their entire belief. "We the jurors find the prisoner guilty and affix the term of
confinement in the County Jail 'four months' and therefore it being demanded of the
prisoner of any thing for himself or his heirs or assigns to pay why the Court should not now
proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to law and nothing being offered or
alleged in delay of judgment. It is therefore considered by the Court that he did
John E. Ricks be confined in the jail of this County for the term of four months to be
paid by the jurors in their verdict as contained and therefore shall be pay the costs
of this prosecution or otherwise discharged by the course of law.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt, E. Boston, John R. Holmes & William B. Smith or any three of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge over the Swamp near Boykin's Depot. receive the Work when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that J. M. Corbett County Treasurer, at of the County levy five and
fifteen ¹⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for building bridge across Gravel Run Dam and the road from
Chapenbungeo mill to the Cedar.

On the motion of William J McKinsty, the executor named in the last will and testament of John McKinsty deceased, proved and recorded in the Court, who made oath according to law and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, but without security the will directing that no bond should be required of him and the Court requiring none, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said William J McKinsty for obtaining a probate of the will aforesaid in due form.

On the motion of Jordan D. Proctor who made oath according to law and together with O'Brien & White & Warren Edwards his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency), entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of fifty hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs - which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Jordan D. Proctor for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William Weston dec'd in due form.

Ordered that James Holmes, Owen White & Patrick Ross being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of William Weston dec^d which may be produced to them, and return the appraisement under their hands according to law.

Charles Beale is appointed Collector in the Township of Boylston Sept in this County to fill the vacancy caused by the failure of Henry S. Hill, who was elected to qualify in due time. And therefore the said Charles Beale with Lawson Beale & E. S. Fells his securities, who justified on oath as to their sufficiency, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1000 to the said County as the law directs which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Charles
