Inquest taken upon the body of King Daughtrey before John E. James Justice of the Peace, returned & ordered to be filed.

Caleb Darden who stands accused of housebreaking with intent to commit larceny, was set to the Bar in custody of the jailor of this Court and the Indictment against him being returned "not a true bill" proclamation was made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the said Caleb Darden it is ordered that he be discharged from custody.

On the application of Wm. A. Camp for leave to erect a dam across Tarara Creek near its mouth and a short distance from the McCherrin River, in this County, and to erect a Saw & grist mill thereat. It appearing to the Court that there O. C. Lewis, Wm. M. Beaton, Lucy Kindred, David H. Kindred, Benj. B. Kindred, Henry Kindred, Bettie I. Kindred tenants of the freehold of the land upon which it is desired to abut the dam have had ten days notice of this application and they being solemnly called and not appearing It is therefore ordered that a Writ of Ad quod damnum be issued to be directed to the Sheriff of Southampton County commanding him to summon and impanel a jury composed of twelve freeholders of this County, to meet on the day of 187 at the lands on which the said Saw & grist mill is to be erected, and that the said writ with the inquest to be made in pursuance thereof be returned to Court.

The Court certifies that Warren Edwards, Wm. A. Bradshaw, James R. West, James T. Hill, Eley Bryant, Robert Whitchard, James A. Williams & Joseph T. Williams are entitled to one dollar each for their services this term as grand jurors to be paid out of the County levy.
