We the undersigned Commissioners appointed by your Honor to let out and receive the work done in repairing Purcells bridge & Embankment respectfully report, that as per your order we let out the same to Hartwell Powell with John C. Thomas as Surety, as the lowest undertaker in the sum of \$304⁵⁰ - three hundred four dollars and fifty cents - Southampton Countys part being (\$182⁷⁰) One hundred & eighty two dollars and seventy cents ($\frac{3}{8}$ ¹⁴) And on the 10 Decr. 1872. we met and having found the work done according to Contract received received the same and respectfully its ratification by the Court. All of which is respectfully submitted. Jno. O. Griffin, Jas G. Jones & T. Stephenson Commrs. Which report is ratified & confirmed by the Court.

Ordered that J. M. Corbett County Treasurer out of the County Levy pay to Hartwell Powell One hundred & eighty two ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ dollars, this Countys proportion for repairs to Purcells bridge & Embankment.

Ordered that James Holmes be appointed Commissioner to let to the lowest undertaker the clearing off rafts from Joyners bridge for twelve months next ensuing.

Ordered that John O. Griffin, Jas G. Jones & Samuel H. Holmes do let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding of the Bridge over Terrapin Swamp on the Black Water Road, receive the same when completed and make report to Court.

Ordered that J. M. Corbett County Treasurer, out of the County Levy pay Joshua B. Crumpler One hundred dollars for keeping Ferry at Monroe till 31st December 1872.

On the application of J. D. A. Barham who wishes to obtain license to keep an Ordinary & retail ardent spirits thereat at Berlin in this County It appears to the Court that the applicant is a person of sobriety & good character and the place fit & convenient.
