225 acres of land. It is therefore ordered that he be Exonerated from the payment of the
said sum of \$4.95 if not paid, if paid that it be refunded him.

A. J. Cornell who was summoned to appear here this day as a juror was solemnly called but
came not therefore it is ordered that he be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next Term
of this Court designated for the trial of civil causes, to show cause, if any, he can, why he should not be
fined for his said Contempt.

R. B. Prellow, J. H. Dykes & James D. Westbrook who were summoned to appear here this
day as grand jurors were solemnly called, but came not. Therefore it is ordered that they be summoned
to appear here on the first day of the next Term of this Court designated for grand jurors, to
show cause, if any they have, why they should not be fined for their said Contempt.

For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that John E. Ricks who was convicted at
the last December Term of this Court of breaking & entering on an outhouse not adjoining to or occupied with
a dwelling house & sentenced to be confined in the County Jail for the term of four months, be released
from his confinement at the expiration of the said four months. It being proved to the satisfaction of the
Court that the said John E. Ricks is & will be unable to pay the costs of the prosecution.

On the motion of Walter B. Person and it appearing to the Court that the said Person is
charged on the assessor's land book with 504 acres of land which turns out by recent survey
to be only 352 acres. Ordered that the assessor correct his book accordingly.

Ordered that James M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay James C. Little
fifty dollars for building or repairing bridge across Terrapin Swamp.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning Ten O'clock
