Cap sill 8 + 10. 10 feet long, & Strainers 3 + 10. 10 feet long, bridge floor to be 2 inches thick, Abutments of 2 inch Planks, and the above timber to be sent from or Cypress except mudsills which may be Sap - Hand rails 3 + 4 brace in bunch planks, said rails to be bent.

The Embankment and Bridge to be 12 feet wide at top the Embankment to be lined with floor of Bridge, from hill to hill, and allowed to form a Natural Road - Road line to submit the following Report - The above work was let to Mr. Carter for \$185. work to be completed by 15th day of Sept. 1872.
