Ordered that S. Lewis, L. B. Cobb & Wm J. Richardson, let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Boner's bridge across Black-Creek bridge receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridges across Atterway Swamp near Maspburgs Mill. this day made a report which is in these words - "To the Hon. Judge of the County Court, Southampton County - We the Commissioners ordered by the County Court - Southampton to let to lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridges across Atterway Swamp at Maspburgs bridges - beg leave to make this our report - We let to A. Carter this work for \$15 - Respectfully Submitted Warren Edwards, Gilem Edwards, Comrs." Which report is ratified and Confirmed by the Court -

Sam Johnson who stands indicted for assault with intent to commit rape, was set to the Bar in Custody of the jailor of this Court and being arraigned thereof pleaded not guilty to the Indictment; and a panel of sixteen persons summoned by the Sheriff were examined by the Court and found free from all legal exception & qualified to serve as jurors according to law. Williams, Henry Ferguson, Eley Bryant, Ben Knight, Seymour Clougham, Cara Beale, Robert Blythe, & Robert Whitehead were elected tried and sworn the truth of and upon the premises to speak, and having heard the evidence upon their oaths do say "We the jury find the prisoner guilty and ascertain the term of his imprisonment in the penitentiary two years." And thereupon the prisoner is remanded to Jail.
