

Commissioners appointed to let the rebuilding of a Bridge near Blain Miller Call the Wy Bridge. This day made a report stating that H^W Bawling agent for M^W B. Westbrooke agreed and bound himself to build the said bridge, agreeable to specifications for one hundred dollars - the Court ratifying and confirming the said contract, said bridge when completed - and make report to Court.

Ordered that P. J. Nichols, C. F. Pettlow and J. J. Swathney be appointed Commissioners to let out the repair of the Canal and Mill swamp bridges and road leading from Inver Wipost to Pettlows Bridge and report same to Court.

Ordered that the Account of Mrs. Josephine F. Howard jailor of Southampton County amounting to Forty four dollars and seventy cents, be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination and payment.

The Court taking into consideration the report of the Commissioners made at the last term with regard to the repairs of Jones Bridge across the three creeks, doth ratify and confirm the same, and doth order that the Commissioners Robt. Ridley, H. T. Barham and R. F. Barham do view and receive the said bridge when completed according to contract and make report to Court.
