R. Barham who were summoned to appear here this day as witnesses for the defendants, were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is ordered that they be summoned to the first day of the next term of this Court, for the trial of Civil causes by jury to show cause if any they can why they should not be fined for their said contempt.

An Inquisition taken on the 3rd of June 1873 before W. B. Holland a Justice of the Peace of this County, upon the view of the body of Preston Johnson there lying dead was received and ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the account of Charles Beale amounting to five ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars be paid to the Auditor of Public accounts for her examination and payment.
