And thereupon the said Cornelius Diggs with George Jordan Henry Thompson & Georges Marini his Securities here in Court severally acknowledged in the sum of One hundred dollars and his said Securities in the like sum of One hundred dollars of their goods and chattels, lands and Tenements to be levied to the use of the Commonwealth. Yet upon this condition that if the said Cornelius Diggs shall make his personal appearance before this Court on the first day of the next Term thereof to answer for the offence aforesaid of which he stands charged and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance to be void or else to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Ordered that John C. Griffin & Nat. Fells be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next Term of this Court & show cause if any they have why informations should not be filed against them upon presentments made by the grand jury against them this day.

Ordered that William Edwards Warren Edwards, Robert Lewis, Mr. E. Beale or any three of them do let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridges & Embankment at Cypressbridge and said Commissioners will report what repairs are necessary.
