Knight five of the Commissioners appointed at the February & May Terms last of this Court this day made reports - a majority and a minority report with specifications - relative to the repairing of the old embankment bridges and as to the propriety of changing the present location or site of the present Bridge across the Nottoway River at Jerusalem. And on consideration thereof it is ordered that Charles E. Knight J. D. Pretlow Tho. Vaughan J. H. Williams, James Devaney & Richard H. Blythe, any three of whom may act, be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs & rebuilding of the embankment at Jerusalem. And in letting said work the said Commissioners are directed to let the route reported by J. D. Pretlow, Tho. Vaughan J. H. Williams & Henry Ferguson & the route reported by Charles E. Knight. both routes to be let according to specifications filed by Charles E. Knight, that is, the work to be done according to the principles of those specifications with the understanding that the undertaker of either route is to warrant the same for ten years free from any expense to the County ~~except such repairs as are needed annually in the old Embankment~~. And the said Commissioners may let said routes without any warranty for years. And make report to Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until the first day of the next Term.
