

Tuesday July 29th 1873

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Present The Hon. J. W. Vaughan Judge

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let the repairs of Carys bridge this day made a report which is ratified and confirmed by the Court and ordered to be recorded and is in these words, to wit: "We the undersigned Commissioners for the repairs of Carys bridge by leave to report, that as the bridge was not built in strict accordance with the original specifications we have allowed Mr. Jno. Mills nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) for the completion of the whole work, a part of which is yet to be done for the completion of which he has given his bond - This action we respectfully submit to the Court - July 26. 1873 - J. E. Sebell, B. W. Nicholson, E. C. Magee, W. B. Saunders - Signed by B. W. Nicholson for them by request -

Ordered that James M. Corbitt County Treasurer pay John J. Mills out of the County levy nine hundred dollars for repairs to Carys bridge across Malloway river -

On the motion of James Drury who made oath according to law, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to law but without security, the will directing none to be required and the Court requiring none - which bond is ordered to be recorded - Certificate is granted the said James Drury for obtaining a probate of the will of James D. Drury - in which he is named as executor - recorded in this Court on the 2^d instant in due form -

Ordered that Wm. Morrell, N. S. Pond & A. L. Francis being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of James D. Drury dec^d which may be produced to them and return the appraisement under their hand according to law -

Ordered that the account of Joseph M. Prince Attorney for the Commonwealth in this Court amounting to fifteen dollars & the account of W. W. Briggs Sheriff amounting to thirteen dollars, be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment -

An Inquest taken on the 8th day of July 1873 upon view of the body of Mills A. Britt was returned and ordered to be filed -
