This day came as well the attorney for the Commonwealth as the Defendant, by his attorney and thereupon came a Jury to wit, Robert Allen, Augustus Smith, A. Bradshaw, Jas E. Lawrence, Henry Moss, Wm Brantley, Calvin Scarborough, John F. Davis, J. St. Johnson, E. C. Story, Thos Bradshaw and Burgess Herring, who being elected took and sworn the oath to speak upon the issue joined, upon their oath to say, "We the Jury find the Defendant guilty, and a fine of five dollars at our Court." Therefore it is considered by the Court, that the Commonwealth recover against the Defendant the fine aforesaid apaid, and the costs of this prosecution.

Ordered that J. F. Story, Burg J. Bryants, Warren Edwards, E. R. Fries, Davis Barrett, Robert Stevens and J. F. Watkins be and they are hereby appointed Viewers (any three of whom may act) that they proceed to view and locate a road leading from Sign post on west side of Kettleway River near Cypress Bridge to Handsome Sept on S. J. R. R. That they report to Court what damages are charged by any land owner, whether any yards, orchard or garden will have to be taken, and they will also report to Court any other facts relating to said road, that they may deem pertinent.

This day the Report of J. C. Mills, Warren Edwards, S. H. Bishop and Chas E. Knight, relative to the Building of a Bridge over Kettleway River at the Seaboard & Roanoke Rail Road, and an Embankment on the West side of said River, came up to be heard together with a petition of C.
