

Ordered that James M. Corbitt Treasurer, out of the County Levy, pay to
 C. Randall the sum of thirty dollars and fifty cents, for repairs to Bridge and
 Finner's Mill race.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let the repairs of the Bridge of Southampton
 at Copperbrook Swamp this day made the following report: "In the Town Bridge of the
 County of Southampton: In accordance with the order made at June Term of
 your Court the undersigned Commissioners proceeded to examine the repairs necessary
 to the Bridge at Copperbrook Swamp and the embankments and also the Bridge
 and Embankment at Mill Swamp on the road leading from Iron to Finner's Bridge
 and after duly considering them, herewith report that they deem necessary particu-
 larly at Copperbrook Swamp they found the bridge which was washed up entire-
 ly too short & considered it absolutely necessary to have one of twice its length.
 After the usual notice of ten days they proceeded further to let the work be
 bidder the rebuilding of the Bridge & the completion of the necessary repairs.
 It was undertaken by J. C. Griffin for the sum of two hundred and twenty
 dollars, an amount which your Commissioners by leave to say they consider
 very reasonable for the County to give. Herewith you will find the statement of
 the work necessary & they ask your honor to sanction their proceeding
 so that J. C. Griffin may complete the work as agreed on. The Undertaker is to
