

On the Motion of John Good, Jr., who reads Court according to law, and together with James B. Urquhart and Richard W. Burgess his Securites, (who justify on Court as to their Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Seventy Thousand Dollars, Conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said John Good, Jr., for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of William St. Urquhart. (Unadministered by James B. Urquhart the former Executor died with the will annexed in due form.)

On the Motion of William M. Beatty, who reads Court according to law, and together with James M. Corbitt his Security, (who justify on Court as to his Sufficiency,) entered into and acknowledged a Bond in the penalty of Fifteen Thousand Dollars, Conditioned according to law, which Bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said William M. Beatty for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Mills A. Smith died in due form.

Ordered that J. R. Bryant, Geo. W. Harrison, Geo. H. Holmes & Edwin Harris, (or any three of them,) being first duly sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the goods & chattels of Mills A. Smith died and return the appraisement under their hands according to law.

The Last Will & Testament of William B. Vick died was proved by the Oaths of Davis Barrett & L. J. Miles two of the Subscribing witnesses thereto, and is ordered to be recorded.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let to the County Undertaken the repair of Furells Bridge of Embankment, this day made their report which is in strong words, to wit: "To the Honorable Judge of the County Court of Southampton; We the Undersigned appointed Commissioners by your Honor for the purpose of letting out and receiving the repairs to Furells Bridge, and Embankment, beg leave respectfully to report that we in conjunction with the Commissioners on the part of John Wight, met and hearing found the work done according to Contract (as reported to your Honor at the August term of your Court,) received the same, which action we request your Honor to ratify. We would further report that there being some extra work necessary, we allowed the Contractor James T. Pooder (\$10.00) ten dollars in addition making the whole (\$210.00) Two hundred & ten dollars. Southampton's part being (\$124.00) One hundred & twenty four dollars; Wight our hands this 12th day of September 1873."
