

Ordered That James M. Cortitt, Treasurer ^{of this County}, out of the County levy, pay to James T. Burden, the sum of one hundred & twenty five dollars, for County proportion, for the repairs to Furells Bridge & Embankment over Blackwater River.

Ordered That Elliott L. Story, A. G. & John White, he and they are hereby appointed Viewers to view the ground, and to report to the Court, the convenience and inconveniences that will result by well to individuals as to the public, from the opening of a road from the Quaker Road to the Quaker Church to connect with the road leading to Franklin near Braces Stone; also a short road of about three fourths of a mile, leading from the said road to the road near Mrs Jane W. Perkins.

Ordered That James Holmes, John J. Harris, John Turner, Wm. J. Richardson, and L. C. Cortt, he and they are hereby appointed Commissioners (any three of whom may act,) to apportion Taxes to Mary Turner widow of Josephus Turner decd, and make report to Court?

Ordered That Wm. H. Ackersden, Wm. A. Bell, Burrus Parrott, J. B. Bailey & John A. Carter, he and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, (any three of whom may act,) to divide the Lands belonging to the Estate of Bennet S. Briggs decd among William Briggs, Ann Briggs, Benjamin Briggs, Rebecca Briggs, Effie Briggs and Bessie Briggs, & heirs of said Bennet S. Briggs decd and make report to Court?

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to look to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge & Embankment on the road leading from Sen to Furells Bridge this day made the following report, to wit: "We the Hon Judge of the County Court of Southampton, the undersigned Commissioners for viewing & letting the repairs to Bridge & Embankment on the Road leading from Sen to Furells Bridge, beg leave to report, that they have examined the work as done by the Contractor and consider it as completed in the main, and in those respects exceeding the specifications of the Contract, and report respectfully ask that your Honor sanction this Report, receive said work, considering him (the Contractor) as entitled to the amount, one hundred & sixty dollars, for the performance of said work."
