The said Undertaker agrees to do the work and to keep the raft clear from the Bridge for twelve months, for Forty Nine dollars. 2 Oct 20th 1873.

Which report is ratified and confirmed by the Court, and it is ordered that the said Commissioner take bond and Security from the said Undertaker, for the faithful performance of his Contract, and make report to the Court.

The Commissioners heretofore appointed to let to the lowest bidder, the repairing and rebuilding of the Bridge across Appomattox Swamp on the road leading from J. P. Parkin's to Port Whithead's according to Specifications to be furnished by them, this day made the following report, which is in these words, to wit: "Dunkampson Co. Va. Sept. 27th 1873, Specifications for building the lower Appomattox Bridge, to consist of 11 wood sills 21 ft long to face 12 in heart uprights & capsills & braces all to be 10 + 12 in of heart, 8 in girts 8 + 12 in all girts and to be braced on the capsills to be 12 in all, brack planks to be 12 in wide 14 ft long, all flooring to be 11 ft long 2 in thick bottom and up railing and to be 4 + 4 in post, for the railing and to be 12 in wide at bottom and 4 in at top, 3 wood sills to be put in the ground level with the top of the ground the Bridge and to be built 2 ft above high water mark, the buttments to be done up with the old girts in panel form braced together the edges sufficiently to prevent the water from washing out the dirt with lead, buttments to be put in good order. All timbers to be good heart pine or Cypress, the Bridge to be completed by the 15th of December 1873, the spans to be 21 1/2 feet long. The work was let to Wm. H. Nicholson for \$329. Hundred and twenty Nine (\$329) dollars, to be completed by Dec. 15th 1873.

We recommend the bid be confirmed.
