

the oath required by law

Charles Beale the senior Constable of the Township of Boykin in this County is appointed Collector of said Township under the act of Assembly approved April 2^d 1873 intitled "An act to amend and re-enact Section 75 of Chapter 230 of Acts of 1871-72 as to duties and Compensation of Certain Township Officers approved July 11th 1872 and acts amendatory thereof" And thereupon the said Charles Beale gave an additional bond with Lawson Beale & Augustus Smith his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Sallie A. Eley who made oath according to law and together with Wm H Jenkins & Mills E Stephenson her securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. Certificate is granted the said Sallie A. Eley for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of A. E. B Jones deceased in due form.

Ordered that R. M. Dole, C. M. Joyner, John Brittle Murdock W Clayton & James E Stephenson or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of A. E. B Jones dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands according to law.

A Writing bearing date the 23^d day of March 1872 purporting to be the last Will and testament of James G Jones deceased was produced in Court by A. T. Stephenson the executor therein named and there being no subscribing witness thereto L. W. Low R Edwards and M. E. Stephenson were sworn and severally deposed they are well acquainted with the testator's hand writing and verily believe the said writing and the name thereto subscribed to be of the testator's proper hand writing. Whereupon the said writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last Will and testament of the said James G Jones deceased. And on the motion of the said A. T. Stephenson the executor who made oath according to law and together with Willis Bradshaw Mills E Stephenson W Clayton & R W Clayton his securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six thousand dollars conditioned according to law. Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that R. M. Dole, C. M. Joyner, John Brittle Murdock W Clayton & James E Stephenson, or any three of them being first duly sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods and chattels and real estate of James G Jones deceased which may be produced or shown to them and return the appraisement under their hands according to law.

The Court doth assign Zachariah Doyle Guardian of Mary Ann Elizabeth & William T Turner orphans of Josephus Turner dec^d. And thereupon the said Zachariah Doyle with J. A. Pickett & Odium White his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded.

William T Johnson a minor over the age of fourteen years having nominated Joseph B. Prince for his guardian of which the Court approves, and thereupon the
