

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay Joseph B. Parnica attorney for the Commonwealth in this Court one hundred and twenty five dollars in full of the balance due him for his public services for the year ending 31st December 1873.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy W. W. Briggs four hundred and fifty dollars for his public services as sheriff for the year ending 31st December 1873.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay L. B. Edwards Clerk of this Court three hundred dollars for his public services for the year ending 31st December 1873.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay to Richard A. Blythe & John D. Blythe twenty dollars each for guarding the jail of this County during the confinement of prisoners therein charged with felony.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay E. J. Gardner assignee of R. A. Halcomb twenty dollars for guarding the jail of this County during the confinement of prisoners therein charged with felony.

Ordered that J. M. Corbitt County treasurer out of the County levy pay C. C. Williams assignee of N. B. Bryant twenty dollars for guarding the jail of this County during the confinement of prisoners therein charged with felony.

For reasons appearing to the Court A. M. Williams, John E. Coker, Newt Branch, Calvin Bearborough & Burrill Barrett are appointed viewers (any three of whom may act) to view the ground along which it is proposed to run a new road to run from the Cabin point-road near J. W. Urquhart to the Coltham road near W. Ponds. Ordered that said viewers or any three of them view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public, if such road shall be as proposed, and especially whether any yard, garden, orchard, or any part thereof, will in such case have to be taken.

To Dr. E. C. Barrett physician appointed to attend the prisoners confined in the jail of this County from time to time, fifty dollars are allowed for the two quarters ending 31st December 1873.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned until Wednesday next the 24th Inst. at 10th o'clock.
