Ordered that James M. Corbitt County Treasurer, out of the County funds pay to Carter & Co. the sum of Twenty dollars, for building plank-mills at ends of Canal Bridge year following Sept.

This day the report of E. S. Story, Edwin White and A. Garrett, Commissioners, be laid out the road from the Quaker Church to Cherry's Church, same to be surveyed, and the Court rejecting the said Report, doth adjudge, and order, that the same Commissioners, select the said Road, and report again to the Court.
