On the motion of Oran Dole, It is ordered that Wm. H. Briggs, Sheriff of
 this County, take into his hands the Estate of Nathan Johnson dec'd and administer
 upon the same according to law, he being dead and without heirs, and no person applying
 for administration on his estate.

Ordered that Willis Bradshaw, Jacobus Johnson & John Roe, (who are hereby
 appointed Commissioners for the purpose) do let to the County Roadmaster,
 the repairs of Black Creek Bridge, and make report to the Court.

On the motion of Joseph L. Bradshaw, to have a new Road established
 from the Blackhead legal post near St. Peter's Mill to Newcomb's Point, It is ordered
 that Henry Ferguson, James H. Williams & James S. Hill, be appointed Commissioners,
 to view the route, and report to the Court the Consequences and inconveniences
 that will result to individuals as well as to the public, if such road
 or highway shall be as proposed, and especially whether any field, garden,
 Orchard, or any part thereof, will in such case stand to be taken?

Ordered that Charles E. Knight be appointed a Special Commissioner
 to let to the County Roadmaster the keeping in repair, of the Embankment
 on west side of Holloway River at Jerusalem, for the period of
 twelve months, and make report to Court.

A writing or power of attorney bearing date the 14th day of March 1894,
