Waggoner Judge of the County Court of Southampton The undersigned Commissioners appointed by an Order of the County Court of Southampton at the December Term 1873, to relate to the lowest Underbidder the Embankment and Bridges on the west side of Nottoway River at Jerusalem beg leave to report that in pursuance of the said Order they proceeded to select the same on Saturday the 10th of January 1874, to be completed according to the Specifications incorporated in the Contract made by the Commissioners duly appointed by a former Order of the said Court, with John Wiley and Salathiel Lewis making the lowest bid to wit: The sum of Fifty Dollars the Contract for the completion of the said work was duly awarded to him he executing his bond in the penalty of One hundred dollars for the performance of the Contract according to the Specifications, the said Bond being duly filed, and to day we have examined the said work, to wit: The Embankment, Bridges which were to be built and are found them completed according to Contract and we have received it and recommended the Court to pay Salathiel Lewis the Fifty dollars for completing the said work and also to pay to him the residue to wit: the sum of Two thousand and fifty dollars he being the last Contractor under John Wiley, and having done the work; we also recommended the Court to pay to the said Salathiel Lewis the sum of One hundred dollars in addition to the amounts heretofore paid for extra work done on the said Embankment and Bridges at our Special instance and request.
