 Beale, the one cent as aforesaid, and the Costs of this prosecution,
 and as to the Defendant Barney being solemnly called and not
 appearing, on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth
 it is ordered that the Rule aforesaid be made absolute as to
 him, and an Information be filed against him upon the
 presentment aforesaid, which being done, It is ordered that
 he be summoned to the first day of the next Term to
 answer the said Information.

J. V. Olson having offered a reasonable excuse for his
 non appearance here at the last Term of this Court,
 It is ordered that the Rule made against him be discharged.

James E. Gillette Collector in the Berding Iron Township, in
 this County, this day tendered his resignation to date
 from the 1st day of May, 1874, which the Court accepts.

 out of the County Surplus pay William James the Sum of
 (\$15) Fifteen Dollars, for repairing the Bridge across the people's

 to view the route and report to the Court the Commission and
 incumbrances that will result as well to individuals as to the
 public, by the opening of a new road from the Blackhead
 Sign post, over H. S. Piper's mill, to Kousen's Depot, this day
 made the following report, to wit: To the County Court of
 Southampton County Pursuant to an Order of the
 County Court of Southampton County, rendered at the
 March Term 1874, to cut a new road from the Blackhead
 Sign post to Kousen's Depot, was let to the lowest bidder
