O. C. Vaughan a Justice of the Peace in the Franklin Township ^{this County} in this day returned to

 three ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ dollars for repairs of Court square.

On the motion of David Branch Col^d and for reasons appearing to the Court he is exempted from
