this writ - And the writ of Seize facias not having been executed on the defendant
Thomas Johnson on the motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth an alias writ of
Seize facias is awarded against that defendant returnable here to the first day of
July Term next.

with the inquest taken in pursuance thereof when complete and signed by the jurors, etc.
returned by the said Sheriff according to law.
