

recover against the said defendant her costs expended in suing forth and prosecuting this writ. And the writ of *habeas corpus* not having been exhibited on the defendant Thomas Johnson on the motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth an alias writ of *habeas corpus* is awarded against that defendant returnable here to the first day of July Term next.

On the petition of R P Pope & Joseph B Pope who wish to build manufacturing machinery on their lands on Myricks Swamp in this County of which they are the owners in fee simple and to erect a dam ^{for permission} across the stream near the road leading from Newmans Depot to the Crawford road. This day came the petitioners by their attorney and the summons awarded against James I Darden & Simon Beale ^{at the last term of this Court} being returned executed, they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore on the motion of the petitioners it is ordered that ^{another} writ of *ad quod damnum* be awarded them to the Sheriff of Southampton County to be directed to be executed on the 8th day of July next according to law and with the inquest taken in pursuance thereof which is completed and signed by the jurors be returned by the said Sheriff according to law.

John M Harrison who was elected Township Clerk in the Township of Boykins in this County by the qualified voters thereof at the election held on the 28th day of May 1874 for the Term of One year commencing on the 1st day of July 1874 and after said Term of Office shall have expired to continue to discharge the duties of said Office until his successor is duly qualified, this day with Wm M Beaton his Security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Harrison also took & subscribed the oath of Office.

Wm P Sebrill who was elected Commissioner of Roads in the Township of Boykins in this County, by the qualified voters thereof at the election held on the 28th day of May 1874 for the Term of one year commencing on the 1st day of July 1874 and after said Term of Office shall have expired to continue to discharge the duties of said Office until his successor is duly qualified, this day with C M Corbitt his Security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Sebrill also took and subscribed the oath required by law.
