

to erect a dam across the said stream near the road leading from Newson's Depot, to the Crawford road. Met upon the premises on the 8th day of July 1894, and being sworn by the Sheriff of said County, proceeded to view the lands on which the said dam is proposed to be erected and also the lands which will be overflowed or taken; and also to inquire whether the mansion house of any person, or the out houses, yards, garden or orchards thereon, belonging will be overflowed or taken, and also whether the health of the neighbors will be annoyed by the stagnation of the waters or otherwise, do agree upon and give the following verdict: The dam will be built entirely on the lands of the petitioners R. P. and Jos. P. Pike eleven feet high, no mansion house, or the out houses, yard, garden or orchards of any person will be taken, the health of the neighbors will not be annoyed. Seven and fourtenth acres of the lands of James D. Darden will be overflowed and taken, and we appraise his damages at twenty eight and 85/100 dollars; a portion of lands of Lemus Deal will be overflowed and taken, estimated at six acres, and for her damages the petitioners have fully satisfied her, as will appear by her certificate herewith returned: all the other lands overflowed and taken, belong to the petitioners R. P. Pike and Joseph D. Pike

And for reasons appearing to the Court the said motion is continued until the first day of the next term of this Court.

Ordered that P. D. Story, David Arnold, Robt. Scruse, William E. Deal and R. A. Donnell Commissioners of roads for Newson's Township, any three of whom may act be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest under bidder the repairs of the Cypress Bridge and make report to Court.

Ordered that P. A. Cloud, Commissioner of Roads for Newnesville Township, let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the bridge across Person's Mill pond and report to Court.
