Ordered that Robert Whitehead Commissioner of Roads for Jerusalem Township be to lowest undertaker the repairs of the old Mill Bridge, and make report to Court.

Ordered that Robert Whitehead Commissioner of Roads for Jerusalem Township, P. A. Daniels Commissioner of Roads for Hudsons Depot Township, and N. J. Barham Commissioner of Roads for Boykins Township, after carefully inspecting the Embankment on the west side of Bottomway River at Jerusalem, report to Court what is necessary to be done to said Embankment and Bridges, in order to render the same secure and permanent.
