The day came the attorney for the Commonwealth as well as the Defendant by his attorney, and by their consent it is considered by the Court that the Commonwealth recover of the Defendant one Court fine and the Costs of this prosecution.

On the petition of Sundry Citizens of this County who wish a good and permanent crossing of the Northway River and long grounds at Jerusalem, It is ordered that Robert Whithead Commissioner of Roads for Jerusalem Township, R. A. Barrett Commissioner of Roads for Kenner's Dept Township and St. F. Barlow Commissioner of Roads for Boykins Township, after carefully inspecting the Embankment on the west side of Northway River at Jerusalem, report to Court what is necessary to be done to said Embankment & Bridges in order to render the same secure & permanent.

The Consent of the Court is given to Elizabeth Bell, to bind her Infant child Thomas Henry Bell of the age of 16 years on the 22nd day of December 1874, until he arrives to the age of twenty one years to Robert J. J. the said J. J. paying to the said Elizabeth Bell twenty five dollars per year from this date, and also pay to the said Thomas Henry Bell twenty five dollars when he shall have attained the age of twenty one years, and also furnish him with clothing board and also teach or cause to be taught him reading writing & Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three.

We are confident a lower bid will never be made, and hope it will meet with your approval - this bridge has been down about two years to the great annoyance of our Community - The bid of Mr Worrell is considerably lower than any ever been made before and if we are ever to have the bridge rebuilt which is positively required by our
