John Artis who stands committed to Jail charged with murder was this day set to the bar in custody of the jailor And thereupon on the motion of the said John Artis and for reasons appearing to the Court he is allowed to give bail for his personal appearance before the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next Term of the said Court to answer the Commonwealth for the offence with which he stands charged That said John Artis to be bound in the sum of three hundred dollars and his securities in the sum of twenty five dollars each And thereupon the said John Artis with Geo. A. Myergrave, R. P. Pope, Jas. E. Sebrell, W. W. Briggs, C. W. Pope, Wm. R. Worrell, Geo. B. Pope, Tho. J. Fox, J. B. Pope, A. J. Francis, Charles Knight & E. B. Beater his securities here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said John Artis in the sum of three hundred dollars and his securities in the sum of twenty five dollars each, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia if the said John Artis shall make default in performance of the condition underwritten.
