Pursuant to your order rendered at July term 1874 to view and report on the opening of a road from the Cabin point road near Mrs. Jane Cobb to the Cobham road near Mrs. Mariae Rollins, respectfully report that I have viewed the said route and recommend the opening of said road. The Citizens of the vicinity propose to do the same free of cost to the County. I do not think the cost of opening the same would ex-ceed \$50 - I do not think any one would be damaged, nor do I know that any one claims damage.
