Vaughan one amounting to ten dollars and twenty five cents, another to twelve dollars and twenty five cents, another to ten dollars and twenty five cents and another to six dollars and twenty five cents, and another to eight dollars and twenty five cents, be severally certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

On the motion of Lucy F. Prince Guardian of Marilla F. Powell It is Ordered that she be allowed to expend one hundred dollars of the principal of her said Ward's Estate for her board & clothing for the year ^{past}
