William Nulty for R. E. and W. Nulty having made Complaint on Oath before a Justice of the Peace of this County, that William Peterson is justly indebted to them in the sum of two hundred & sixteen dollars and fifty-seven cents, subject to a credit of forty-four dollars and fourteen cents, paid January 1st 1874, which became payable on the 27th day of July 1874, and that the said William Peterson intends to remove his effects out of this State, so that there will probably not be sufficient effects to satisfy the said claim when Judgment is obtained thereon, moved only the ordinary process of law be used to obtain such Judgment; and the Justice hearing issued an attachment against the Estate of the said William Peterson in the hands of C. Vaughan the quarantined in this case failing to appear, it is ordered that he be summoned to the first day of the next term to answer on oath whether he is indebted to the Defendant or has in his possession or control any money or other effects belonging to the said Defendant?
