

On the application of Thomas Geo. with the consent of the late firm of Pyland and Thomas, it is ordered that the license granted to the said late firm of Pyland and Thomas, or and the same is hereby transferred to the said Thomas Geo. to retail foreign spirits &c. at their store at Drumsville, in the County of Southamptn, from the 16th of November ~~1874~~ to the 30th of April 1875. The Court being satisfied after hearing the testimony in favor of the applicants, and being of opinion doth certify that the place where the same is to be sold is suitable and convenient. And the applicants are persons of sobriety and good character, and that they have paid to the proper Officer the tax required by law to be paid on said license.

On the application of S. Sherrick to retail ardent spirits at Keweenaw Point in this County, the Court after hearing the testimony as well for as against the application, refuses to grant the Certificate required by law to enable the applicant to obtain license to retail ardent spirits.
