Sullivan Jr. be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners; that they in any other of them be and they are hereby empowered to make a Contract with some responsible party for the repairs of the Cumberland Bridges on the west side of the Northway River at Jerusalem, according to Specifications of said Commissioners filed the 18th 1874. But the said Commissioners are not authorized to expend in said repairs an amount exceeding fifty hundred dollars. And when the said work is completed, the said Commissioners will receive the same and make report to Court.
